BIG DEMAND FOR FOODBANK

Thurrock Foodbank provided 5373 three day emergency food parcels to local people between April 2018 to March 2019. Of this number, 2263 went to children.

The local food bank's figures feed into a larger national picture with a record increase in food bank use across the UK reported today by the Trussell Trust.

Thurrock Foodbank is backing calls from the Trussell Trust to ensure the benefits system is able to protect people from poverty.

The figures from Thurrock Foodbank are a 12% increase on the same period last year. The charity believes the local increase is due to people struggling with issues with Universal Credit such as the five-week wait.

It has been some time since we have been able to produce a newsletter as we have not had the resources. If you or anyone you know would like to take on the role of looking after our P.R. (including a regular newsletter) please get in touch.
